The Dalits are the lowest in the Indian caste system and therefore have historically been considered “untouchable”. Our Dalit Partnership project serves individuals who have often had little or no help. The project focuses on the building of schools, health centers, and training teachers. With highly educated, healthy, and motivated youth, the Dalits are beginning to see hope in breaking free from their long cycle of oppression.
