

Tahaddi Project

The Tahaddi project (a locally registered NGO) that works in a Beirut shanty town is in need of a physical therapist in a basic clinical setting. The vision of this project is to address the medical needs of the poorest of the poor in this marginalized town south of Beirut. The project serves refugees from neighboring countries that have lost the ability to identify with a nation as their home country. The refugees are marginalized as a people group and not considered a member of existing society.
