The Tahaddi project (a locally registered NGO) that works in a Beirut shanty town is in need of medical doctors for general practice in a basic clinical setting. The vision of this project is to address the medical needs of the poorest of the poor in this marginalized town south of Beirut.

Project Location: Beirut, Lebanon

- Medical consultations to clinic patients, communication with other medical staff on clinic needs
- Recruit medical staff, assess need for medical supplies, maintain relationships with outside medical partners
- Assess quality of care given, supervise and train clinic staff, develop donor partners for needy families for medical services
