

## International Medical Clinic

The clinic is operated through Yonsei Friendship Hospital (YFH) and provides medical support to the mission community in Mongolia, foreigners and the Mongolian population. YFH is a Korean/Mongolian joint venture established by Korean missionaries as an honorary branch of the same hospital in Seoul. The hospital in Ulaanbaatar employs about 30 Mongolian doctors and a small number of Korea expatriate staff.
